COE measures job placement based on the students that complete or graduate from a program and are employed in a related field of study, enlisted in the military, or continued their education. Completers are divided into graduate and non-graduate completers. Graduate completers are students who have completed the program in its entirety, demonstrated the competencies required for the program and have been awarded the appropriate certificates. Non-graduate completers are students who left the program before graduation but acquired sufficient competencies through the program to become employed in the field or a related field of study.

How the Calculation Works

Total Placement Rate Calculation

$$\left(\frac{\text{Total number of completers employed in a related field of study, enlisted in the military, or continued their education}}{\text{(Total amount of completers — exclusions)}} \right) \times 100$$

Graduate Placement Rate Calculation

$$\left(\frac{\text{Total number of graduate completers employed in a related field of study, enlisted in the military, or continued their education}}{\text{Total amount of graduate completers — exclusions}} \right) \times 100$$

Exclusions

Students that might be excluded from the rate are:

- Students who transferred to another program within the institution
- Students who received a 100% refund of tuition after withdrawal from the program
- Students who graduated but are waiting to take their licensure exams
- Students documented to be unavailable to earn a certificate in their programs or to gain employment in the field due to situations such as pregnancy, other serious health-related issues (physical/mental/behavioral), caring for ill family members, incarceration, death etc.
