



Nurse Assistant-Certified & Acute Care

Program Description:

Nurse Assistant– Certified–This program is designed to prepare students for employment as a Certified Nurse Assistant in a variety of settings. Students will learn patient care, observation and communication skills with an emphasis on caring for the geriatric resident in a long-term care facility. The program prepares students to be successful in the work place by teaching employability skills and modeling workplace expectations. The program includes both classroom instruction (theory) and 100 required clinical hours.

Acute Care: The Acute Care-CNA course focuses on broadening the CNA’s scope of knowledge and clinical experience to include skills required to work in an acute care setting such as a hospital. Students taking this course must have successfully completed the NA course & passed the NA state competency test. **Students must show proof of current BLS CPR training.**



Program Prerequisites:

Basic reading test required unless you have a high school diploma or H.S equivalency. If you are attending an adult school program, no testing is required. Call for testing appointment. Testing is free.

Students are required to attend all class/clinical sessions as scheduled. All class/clinical sessions are held in person.

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Program Requirements for Nurse Assistant-Certified Program

- Maintain a minimum of 70% grade average and 93% attendance
- Must be able to perform job functions (physical and sensory demands)
- Must be able to clear a criminal background check (Live Scan). CDPH makes the final approval of Certification. For questions please refer to www.cdph.ca.gov
- Clinical site training (at least 100 hours) is a requirement of this program
- Upon completion of the program, students should possess a willingness to secure employment

Program Requirements for Acute Care Program

- Must have completed NA program with a B or better or completed 6 months as a CNA in a long term care facility
- Must possess current BLS First Aid certification & show card on first day of class
- Must attend all cases as scheduled
- Uniform required (scrubs). Not included in program costs. Specific color requirements: Black Bottoms and Top blue shade called CIEL or CIEW. Uniforms are available for purchase at the school

Enrollment Process

Step 1. Contact Student Services Staff at 909-793-3115 ext. 500 or go to website at cryop.org, click on Adult Students, select Programs, select Adult Program Interest form and complete. Registration staff will call and/or email you to complete the process

Step 2. Complete registration information that is emailed to you and schedule an appointment to meet in person with Student Services, Registration staff

Step 3: Meet in person at the site to complete the enrollment process (Bring legal ID & original social security card)

Step 4: First 2 weeks of school submit Physical Examination (Required form available in Student Services)
